1990 First executive director, Ellen Micklewright, hired. City of Florence donates lot for shelter home.

1991 First domestic violence awareness campaign. Office moves to 7th street.

1992 Shelter home completed. Nancy Sobottka hired as executive director.

1993 FEMA funding started.

1994 Peer counseling begins. President of the board Shawn Murray signed the mortgage note for the 12th street building.

1995 Focus Four crisis line moves to SOS. Voucher and Emergency Housing Assistance programs start.

1996 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program starts. Domestic violence advocate hired.

1997 Volunteer coordinator hired.

1998 Mapleton outreach services begins.

1999 VAWA (Violence Against Women Act) funding begins

2000 Free clothing and household items starts. Legal Aid services start one day per week.

2003 Annual fundraiser started at Elks Club, chaired by Rick Dancer

2005 Sexual assault awareness and self-defense education event held

2009 Bettie Egerton hired as executive director. Shelter accessibility funded by grant.

2011 First annual Siuslaw Open golf tournament.

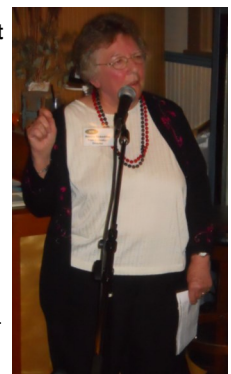
2012 David Wiegand hired as executive director. Shelter remodel funded by grant. Diane Bailiff elected President of the board. Endowment fund established.

2014 Received Non-Profit Achievement Award from Chamber of Commerce. Fundraising for building remodel project secured.
